Programs range from two hours to two days and are suitable for primary, secondary, tertiary, Duke of Edinburgh and international students who want to gain an insight into Australian Indigenous culture.

Programs can be tailored to suit your needs however most popular options are:

- 1) Introduction to Indigenous culture. A 2-3 hour kayaking experience on Tallebudgera Creek escorted by members of the Bundjalung community. Cost: \$ 50.00 pp
- 2) One day experience. This can operate on Tallebudgera Creek or kayak from Seaworld to South Stradbroke. Cost: \$120.00 pp

Students can now join Mark, Aunty Brenda and the Balunjali team and travel the path of the Saltwater Story. It is a story of connection, collaboration, cooperation and continuance of ancient knowledge being passed down to tomorrow's leaders.

- 3) Two day 'Saltwater Story' camp departing from Seaworld to South Stradbroke includes kayak hire, instructor and guide, accommodation and firewood Cost: \$195.00 pp
