3 Day Itinerary

Please note that days of activities and order of activities will be different from the order below due to tides, weather and other factors. All activities will be conducted throughout the course of the school camp unless weather does not permit certain activities.

- Spot turtles, sharks, fish, whales and dolphins from Cape Moreton
- Look for bush tucker and learn about the indigenous culture of Moreton Island
- 4WD along the magnificent Eastern Surf Beach
- Stop for a swim at Blue Lagoon (afternoon Tea)
- 4WD down to the little Sand Hills to enjoy a walk on the giant Sand Dunes

4WD back to Tangalooma Wrecks to enjoy Night Kayaking and refreshments
